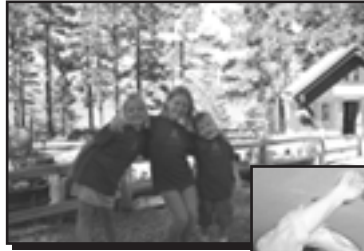


"I love Galilee. It's a great camp with great people. I like how it's not a big camp! It's just small and nice. Galilee is a wonderful place."
